- ❑ Reduce communication overhead and avoid trolls
- ❑ The right place for specific feature discussions
- ❑ Make the development flow clear and structured
- ❑ Allow newcomers to join more easily
- ❑ Scale up more quickly by discussing on tracker instead of unstructured chat
